*Our first vintage of Willow White has aromas of citrus, stone fruit and hints of honeysuckle. A bright acidity on the palate with flavors of fresh grapefruit, peach, pineapple and an elegant finish of lemongrass.*

### THE VINEYARD

*The estate vineyards occupy seven choice acres of the impressive 250-acre D.A. Ranch. The majority of the property remains in a natural state, home to many species of native plants and animals. Our vineyards at the D.A. Ranch bask in Arizona sunshine on rolling hillsides that are cooled by Oak Creek and several natural springs and shaded by tall cottonwood trees.*

### THE WINEMAKING

*Our winemaker uses traditional methods in the early stages of our wine making such as selective picking and sorting, small open-top fermentations and hand punch downs. We generally do not fine or filter, but there are occasions when a rough filtration will brighten the fruit or remove gritty characters.*

### THE WINE

*All of our estate D.A. Ranch wines are made in small batches from 100% Arizona-grown grapes. It is true that the best wines are produced in relatively smaller quantities. Our top quality wines are also offered at a few select restaurants and wine festivals and at the D.A. Ranch by appointment only.*
